Nature and space are the central topics of the internationally working installation artist Markus Heinsdorff who includes domains like architecture, energy generation and recycling into his work. He has initiated and designed projects, installations and buildings all over the world that are marked by an experimental approach to material and structure. Next to his textile and bamboo pavilions he will also discuss the possibilities of low cost building and the use of waste materials.

Markus Heinsdorff is currently working together with the Chair of Building Construction and Material Science at the Technical University Munich for a research project about low cost building. He has been a Visiting Professor in China at the DeTao Masters Academy, the School of Architecture, Southeast University, Nanjing, the School of Architecture and Urban Planning, Huazhong University of Science and Technology, Wuhan and at the Faculty for Architecture, University of Chongqing.
